

CC10 SANITISER

QUATERNARY NO-RINSE SANITISER

DESCRIPTION

CC10 SANITISER is a quaternary ammonium compound based sanitiser for sanitising cleaned surfaces in Food Processing establishments

CC10 SANITISER contains 10% Quaternary ammonium compound and at a dilution of 1:500 is shown to give a greater than Log 5 reduction in viable bacteria. Using BS 1276 1971 Challenge Test

The product **CC10 SANITISER** was tested against:

Escherichia coli ATCC 8739

Salmonella chloraesius ATCC 10708

and Listeria monocytogenes NCTC 11994

AQIS DECLARATION:

A Declaration under Approved Arrangement attesting to the fitness for purpose of **CC10 SANITISER** as a Category 6 SANITISER (No Rinse) for use in Export Meat Establishments is available.

APPLICATION

CC10 SANITISER should be applied to clean surfaces

Apply to cleaned surfaces, cover surface and allow to air dry. Food contact surfaces should be able to drain freely, but do not need to be rinsed before processing

Use at a dilution up to 1:500 with potable water.

For fogging applications use at a dilution of 1 in 500 or 200 ppm Active Quat direct into Fogger
